

The donation will be split evenly among Taiwan's diplomatic allies Belize, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua to publicly, transparently, and quickly enhance their epidemic prevention and containment capabilities.Taiwan donated an infrared thermal imaging camera and one batch of forehead thermometers.On April 15, 2020, National Taiwan University Hospital and senior health officials from eight member states (Belize, Costa Rica, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua, and Panama),
